



Marguerite Salazar has served as Colorado's Insurance Commissioner since Aug. 19, 2013. In this role, she oversees the regulation of the insurance industry in Colorado as head of the Division of Insurance. She works with the insurance industry to bring an inclusive, open, firm and fair-minded regulatory approach to all lines of insurance under her supervision such as life, homeowner, property and casualty, auto, workers' compensation and title insurance.

Recently, she was also appointed by Gov. John Hickenlooper to serve as executive director for the Colorado Department of Regulatory Agencies (DORA; the Division of Insurance is one of nine divisions within DORA).

Prior to joining the state, Ms. Salazar served as the Region 8 Regional Director for the Department of Health and Human Services. She was appointed by President Barack Obama to oversee the implementation of the Affordable Care Act not only in Colorado but also in Wyoming, Montana, Utah, North Dakota and South Dakota. She also led one of the largest Community Health Centers in the country for over 25 years.
